Celebrating 25 years of Independence

The Ontario Paper Thorold Foundation was incorporated in 1958 by the Ontario Paper Company to provide contributions to organizations in the regions of Niagara, Ontario and Baie Comeau, Quebec. The Foundation became independent in 1996 when the Ontario Paper Company supplemental monetary contributions ended. In 2004, the Foundation was split into two entities; one continues to serve the Baie Comeau region in Quebec and the other, the Ontario Paper Thorold Foundation, serves the Niagara region.

The Ontario Paper Thorold Foundation is a registered Canadian charity classified as a Private foundation with seven Directors sitting on the Board. The Foundation meets an annual disbursement quota equal to a minimum 3.5% of invested assets. The Foundation donates to local organizations in Niagara focusing on four program areas with an emphasis on capital projects (bricks and mortar). The four program areas include:

- Health and Wellness
- Education
- Social Services
- Environment
